NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given to the residents of the Town of Enosburgh and the Village of Enosburg Falls, Vermont that the Town Selectboard and Village Trustees will hold a second joint public hearing on February 2<sup>nd</sup> at 6:00 p.m. at the Enosburgh Emergency Services Building to consider for adoption the following Town and Village of Enosburgh, Vermont Comprehensive Municipal Plan pursuant to Chapter 117 of Title 24, Section 4387 and 4384, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

According to Title 24 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated, Municipal Plans must be readopted every five years or they will expire. The Town of Enosburgh and Village of Enosburg Falls underwent a merger of the existing municipal plans and developed a unified plan that comprises both communities; the current Town Plan expires on August 19, 2018 and the Village Plan expires on August 13, 2018. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comment on the adoption of the unified plan for the Town of Enosburgh and Village of Enosburg Falls Comprehensive Municipal Plan and to discuss any comments provided by the public.

The Comprehensive Municipal Plan includes 14 Sections: Section 1 Purpose, Section 2 Community Profile, Section 3 Historic, Archaeological, and Scenic Resources, Section 4 Natural Features, Section 5 Housing, Section 6 Education, Section 7 Public Utilities, Facilities, and Services, Section 8 Transportation Planning, Section 9 Planning for Hazard Resiliency, Section 10 Energy, Section 11 Economy, Section 12 Land Use, Section 13 Compatibility with Neighboring Towns and the Region, Section 14 Implementation. A full text of the plan is on file in Town of Enosburgh Town Office and Village of Enosburgh Falls Village Office. The plan proposes goals and policies that impact the entire community of Enosburgh. This plan is intended to be consistent with the goals established in Title 24, Section 4302.
