NOTICE OF ORDINANCE ADOPTION

Notice is hereby given at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Enosburg Falls, Vermont, held on the 8th day of April, 2003, the Village Ordinance regulating Trees Planted on Private Land from grants obtained by the Village of Enosburg Falls. This ordinance will become effective on the 8th day of June, 2003 unless a petition seeking disapproval thereof is filed with the Village Clerk no more than forty-four (44) days from the above-stated date of adoption.

Section 1: If a private land owner accepts a tree from grants obtained by the Village of Enosburg Falls to be planted outside the Village's public right-of-way the following provisions are required:

Section 2: The landowner shall maintain the tree planted through necessary watering, proper fertilization, and pruning. The Village of Enosburg Falls does not have jurisdiction outside of the public right-of-way. proper maintenance advice may need to be sought at the property owner expense.

Section 3: The landowner shall be responsible for the cost of tree removal should it be necessary due to disease or creating hazardous conditions.
