



# **Enosburg Falls Village Master Plan Steering Committee has Openings!**

The Village of Enosburg Falls was awarded a \$54,000 planning grant from the State of Vermont Better Connections program to prepare a Master Plan. The Village is convening a community Steering Committee to guide the project with the project team and the consultant selected for the work. It is expected that the Committee will meet monthly through September 2019, with a month or two off if there is no business.

The Enosburg Falls Village Master Plan project will engage the community in defining a vision for a vibrant and healthy village center and develop plans and an implementation program to further this vision. The project has the following objectives:

- Improved and safer transportation alternatives in the village center that are connected and integrated with local recreation amenities through proposed wayfinding and other physical complete streets improvements.
- An improved pedestrian experience along Main Street through streetscape enhancements, beautification and site and/or façade design improvements for key properties.
- Enhanced tourism and commerce in the village center with a coordinated marketing and branding program.

The Committee has 2 at-large spaces for interested community members. The other spaces are reserved for representatives of local boards and committees.

The Village Trustees will objectively evaluate any potential candidate based on the following standards: Demonstrated interest in economic development and community health in the village center; ability to be an active participant in committee meetings and project related events; and diversity of background and experience relative to project objectives.
