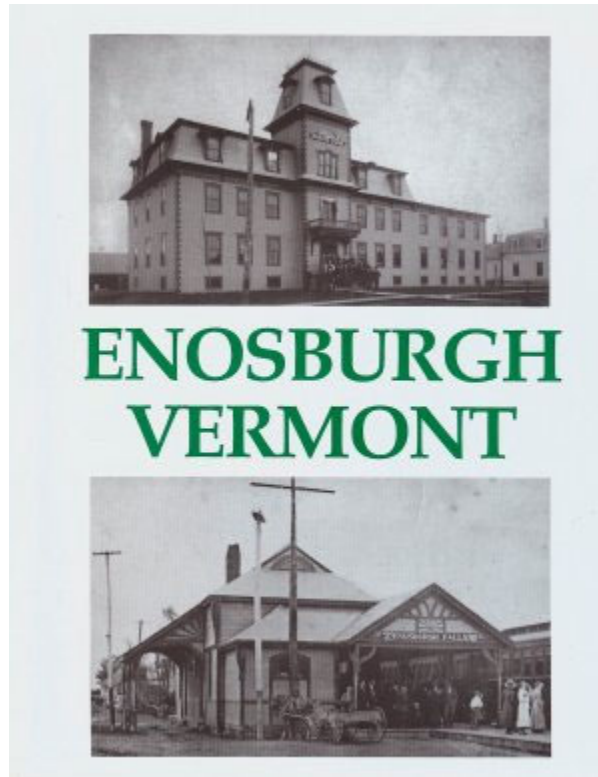


***ENOSBURGH VERMONT* (reprint)**

In 1985 the Enosburgh Historical Society published *Enosburgh, Vermont*. With 231-pages of photographs and descriptions of the town's early families, economic activities, schooling, health coverage, churches, and "the Village" of Enosburg Falls and its outlying communities, this book has been popular for over 30 years. People continue to want copies. In response to this demand the Historical Society has had 100 copies reprinted in a sturdy soft-cover edition.
