NOTICE

Adoption of a Village Policy Ordinance Regulating the Use of Village Parks.

Pursuant to 24 V.S.A. §1972(a), the citizens of the Village of Enosburg Falls are hereby notified that, at a regular meeting held on February 11, 2020, the Village Trustees adopted an Ordinance Entitled: “Village of Enosburg Falls Park Use Policy”, regulating the use of all Village Parks. A brief summary of the Ordinance is set out below:

1. Section 1 requires that all activities requiring permits must comply with the Use Policy.
2. Section 2 described the types of activities that require permits, such as assemblies or events in which twenty or more people are expected to attend; events with amplified sound; events the purpose of which is to disseminate information to the public; or events that involve the erection of any tent, booth or display. This section also sets out the application process and contents of the application form.
3. Section 3 sets out the application review process by the Village Trustees.
4. Section 4 sets out the criteria for review of applications by the Village Trustees, including factors such as public safety, parking, sanitation facilities, potential harm to the park and other considerations.
5. Section 5 sets out conditions for approval of use by large groups of 100 or more people, including the reimbursement of Village costs, and provision of liability insurance.
6. Section 6 sets out the duties and responsibilities of permittees in the use of park facilities.
7. Section 7 sets out the rules for liability of permittees for damages, and the obligation to indemnify the Village.
8. Section 8 contains the requirements for clean up of the parks after the event.
9. Section 9 contains a prohibition of smoking or vaping in Lincoln and Maple Parks.

The complete text of the Ordinance may also be examined, upon request, at the Village Offices at 16 Village Drive, Enosburg Falls, Vermont at any time during normal office hours.

This Ordinance will become effective on the 11th day of April, 2020 unless a petition seeking disapproval thereof is filed with the Village Clerk no more than forty-four (44) days from the above-stated date of adoption. A petition for a vote on the question of disapproving an ordinance or rule shall be signed by not less than five per-cent of the qualified voters of the Village, and

presented to the Trustees or the Village clerk within 44 days following the date of adoption of the ordinance.
