Executive session at 6:18 with a motion by Terry Wright, second by Polly Rico, all in favor so moved.

Out of executive with motion by Polly Rico, second Pierre Letourneau, all in favor so moved at 6:42.

Joey Clark Road Foreman entered meeting. Executive session at 6:43 by motion from Terry Wright, second Dean Wright, all in favor.

Out of executive session at 6:55 with motion by Polly Rico, second by Dean Wright, all in favor, so moved.

At 7:05 the meeting with the Village of Enosburgh Trustees began. Present by Zoom for the Village of Enosburgh was Jonathan Elwell, Village Manager, Samuel Vaillancourt Chair of the Trustees, Leonard Charron, Heather Moore, Cindi Minor, Jason Larose, and Gary Denton as well as Sheriff Roger Langevin.

The topic of the discussion was the noise from all types of vehicles, trucks, cars, motorcycles as well as how the squealing of tires is disturbing as it is on an increase. Some public comments from residents were listened to. Sheriff Langevin has brought in experts to assist his officers with more knowledge in what is legal on vehicles to assist with that aspect of reducing noise. He has noted the problem areas and will direct his team as needed. A couple people volunteered to contact St. Albans about their campaign of Quiet My Ride. Jon Elwell asked about success with speed signs that light up to tell you the speed you are traveling. Some residents want speed bumps considered.

At 7:45 with a motion from Selectboard member Polly Rico, second by Dean Wright, all in favor, so moved. Trustees motion by Heather Moore, second by Cindi Miner, all in favor, so moved.

Out of executive session by Selectboard member Polly Rico, second by Pierre Letourneau, at 8:53, all in favor, so moved. Village of Enosburgh trustee member motion to come out of executive Jason Larose, second by Cindi Miner, all in favor, so moved.

Result of executive session it was tentatively decided to meet again on the trustee's meeting night on November 24, 2020.

Next item on the selectboard regular meeting was to decide who could go to Richford to meet with a couple of Richford selectboard members, Larry Gervais and Terry Wright both volunteered.

Board discussed the meeting they are hosting on October 29<sup>th</sup> to start discussion about regional ambulance service.
