This meeting was held electronically via Zoom Meeting.

Meeting called to order by Samuel Vaillancourt at 6:31 pm.

Samuel Vaillancourt took roll call and read the Electronic Meeting Disclosure.

1. Modifications/Changes to Agenda

There were no changes to the agenda.

2. Public Comment

There were no public comments.

3. Review/Approval of Minutes Meeting January 26, 2021

Leonard Charron made the motion to approve the minutes of the January 26 Meeting of the Board of Trustees as written. Seconded by Cindi Miner. Unanimously approved.

4. Enosburgh Historical Society Request/Historic Preservation Trust Grant Application

Jason Larose made the motion to authorize Jonathan Elwell to send a letter to the Preservation Trust indicating the Village's willingness to discuss extending the current lease with the Historical Society upon its expiration in 2025. Seconded by Cindi Miner. Unanimously approved.

5. Early Debt Retirement Proposal

Cindi Miner made the motion to authorize staff to use \$13,690.23 from General Fund unrestricted reserve and \$40,950.42 from Water Fund unrestricted reserve to retire Community National Bank loan #8850 with an outstanding loan balance of \$70,550.34. Seconded by Leonard Charron. Unanimously approved.

6. Manager's Report

Mr Elwell reported to the Board on four items.

- The annual warning/notice has been posted to the Village's website and at the designated physical posting locations and published in the County Courier and St Albans Messenger and will run a total of four times in each paper. Staff reported that there have been nine (9) absentee ballots requests received to date.
- Vermont's legislative session has begun, and committees are discussing some topics that may affect the electric utilities, including renewable energy requirements, broadband and utility arrearages and Governor Scott's budget proposal includes funding for solar generation and weatherization programs.
- A recent rate comparison provided by Vermont Public Power Supply Authority (VPPSA) indicates Enosburg's electric rates remain right in the middle of the range as compared with sixteen (16) other Vermont utilities.
- The Enosburg Falls Water Dept has received the "2019 Water Fluoridation Quality" award from the CDC for achieving optimal levels of fluoride concentration for twelve consecutive months.
