NOTICE

Alcoholic Beverages on Municipal Property

Pursuant to 24 V.S.A. §1972(a), the citizens of the Village of Enosburg Falls are hereby notified that, at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Enosburg Falls, Vermont, held on the 23rd day of May, 2023, Section 808, Subsection IV(c) of the Village Ordinances, relating to Alcoholic Beverages on Municipal Property was amended as set out below. This Amended Ordinance will become effective on the 23rd day of May 2023, unless a petition seeking disapproval thereof is filed with the Village Clerk no more than forty-four (44) days from the above-stated date of adoption.

(a) Special Rules for Lincoln Park: Any person or organization (“Applicant”) may apply to the Village Trustees for a permit to organize an event or activity at which alcoholic beverages will be sold, served or provided in any form within the confines of Lincoln Park subject to the following rules:

i. Any such event or activity shall comply with the requirements of 7 V.S.A. §67, and all other applicable Village Ordinances.

ii. The Applicant shall submit an application for a permit on a form provided by the Village Manager’s office. Such application shall contain: (a) the name, address, and phone number of each vendor scheduled to appear at the event or activity; (b) the hour, date and estimated duration of the event or activity; (c) the location within the park where the event or activity will take place; (d) proposed arrangements to: insure the safety of the public and the vendors covered under the permit, prevent damage to public and private property; (e) a copy of the application submitted to the Vermont Department of Liquor Control for the event or activity; (f) a copy of the permit issued by the Department for the event or activity, (g) (if applicable) the Applicant has obtained all necessary licenses, permits and approvals from the Village and the State of Vermont for the serving of alcoholic beverages during the use of the park, and will provide them to the Village Manager prior to the 5 days from the commencement date of the event or activity.

iii. Any permit issued by the Village Trustees may contain such conditions and/or restrictions the Trustees may deem necessary to protect public health and safety and to protect public property. Such conditions may include a requirement to have law enforcement personnel present for the duration of the event or activity; have appropriate measures in place to monitor alcohol consumption; and have appropriate refuse receptacles and rest room facilities available on site.

iv. Any event or activity at which alcoholic beverages will be sold, served or provided in any form, held or conducted pursuant to this Ordinance shall comply with 7 V.S.A., Chapter 9, depending on the nature of the event, and shall provide the Village Manager with a copy of the applicant’s alcoholic beverage license and/or event permit no less than seven days from the commencement date of the event or activity.

v The Applicant shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that the vendors comply with all applicable state laws, and shall notify the Village Manager or a member of the Village Trustees immediately in the event or activity that any vendor is in violation of state law, the permit or this Ordinance. Upon receipt of any notice from the Applicant of a violation, or upon receipt of notice of any violations of state law or this Ordinance by a law enforcement officer or Village official or employee, the Village Manager or member of the Village Trustees may revoke the permit issued under this Ordinance effective immediately. Upon such revocation, the Applicant shall take such steps as shall be reasonably required, including the enlistment of assistance from law enforcement personnel, to cause all vendors to cease the serving of alcoholic beverages until further notice from the Village Manager or Village Trustee.

vi. The Village Manager may require each vendor to provide proof of dram shop liability insurance, with terms and coverage limits satisfactory to the Village Manager, and which shall be submitted with the application to the Village Trustees.

Effective Date:

These amendments shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the Village of Enosburg Falls Board of Trustees.
