

**MUNICIPALITY OF ENOSBURG FALLS AND ENOSBURGH TOWN
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given to the residents of the municipalities of Enosburg Falls and Enosburgh Town, Vermont that the joint Enosburg Falls and Enosburgh Selectboard will hold a hearing on April 15, 2024 at 6:00 PM at the Enosburgh Emergency Services Building to consider for adoption the following proposed amendment to the Enosburg Falls and Enosburgh Town Unified Municipal Plan pursuant to Chapter 117 of Title 24, Section 4387 and 4384, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

According to Title 24 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated, Municipal Plans must be amended and readopted every eight years or they will expire. The Enosburg Falls and Enosburgh Town Unified Municipal Plan was adopted on April 20, 2020. The proposed plan amendment will not change the plan expiration date of April 20, 2028. The plan amendment corrects the designated village center boundary, which is necessary in order to seek renewal of the designated village center.

The Enosburgh Town and Enosburg Falls Unified Plan includes 14 Sections: Visions for the future of Enosburgh, Chapter 1 Purpose, Chapter 2 Community Profile, Chapter 3 Historic, Archeological and Scenic Resources, Chapter 4 Natural Features, Chapter 5 Housing, Chapter 6 Education, Chapter 7 Public Utilities, Facilities and Services, Chapter 8 Transportation Planning, Chapter 9 Planning for Hazard Resiliency, Chapter 10 Energy, Chapter 11 Economy, Chapter 12 Land Use, Chapter 13 Compatibility with Neighboring Towns and the Region, Chapter 14 Implementation. A full text of the plan is on file in the Enosburg Falls Village offices and the Enosburgh Town offices. The plan proposes goals and policies that impact the entire Municipalities of Enosburg Falls and Enosburgh Town. This plan is intended to be consistent with the goals established in Title 24, Section 4302.
