Meeting was called to order by Sam Vaillancourt at 6:30 PM

1. Modifications/Changes to Agenda
There were no modifications.
2. Public Comment
There was no public comment.
3. Review/Approve Regular Meeting Minutes for January 23rd, 2024.
A motion was made by Eli Gabuzda to approve the minutes as written. Seconded by Sandra Ferland. Unanimous.
4. Franklin Foods Allocation Request.
A motion was made by Eli Gabuzda to approve the payment plan submitted by Franklin Foods for the allocations for the digester project, adding a 1% late fee for any late payments received. Seconded by Leonard Charron. Unanimous.
It was also discussed that the bond payments will begin being due the first bill in April of 2024 once the allocations are being paid for and this will be billed to Franklin Foods.
5. Discuss 2/27 trustees meeting time, coincides with Annual School Board Meeting
It was determined that this meeting would not impact Enosburg residents and the Trustee Meeting date and time would stay the same.
6. Sign off on Final design loan agreement for Church Street
A motion was made by Sandra Ferland to approve the loan agreement for the Church Street Sewer project. Seconded by Eli Gabuzda. Unanimous.
7. Sign off on Elm Street water project revolving loan program application.
A motion was made by Eli Gabuzda to approve the revolving loan program application for the Elm Street water project. Seconded by Leonard Charron. Unanimous.
8. EBCA Easter Egg Hung Park Application
A motion was made by Sandra Ferland to approve the EBCA Park Use Application for the annual Easter Egg Hunt to be held on 03/30/2024, waiving any fee. Seconded by Eli Gabuzda. Unanimous.
9. General Fund Budget Changes
A motion was made by Eli Gabuzda to approve the changed General Fund tax rate of .8818. Seconded by Sandra Ferland. Unanimous.
